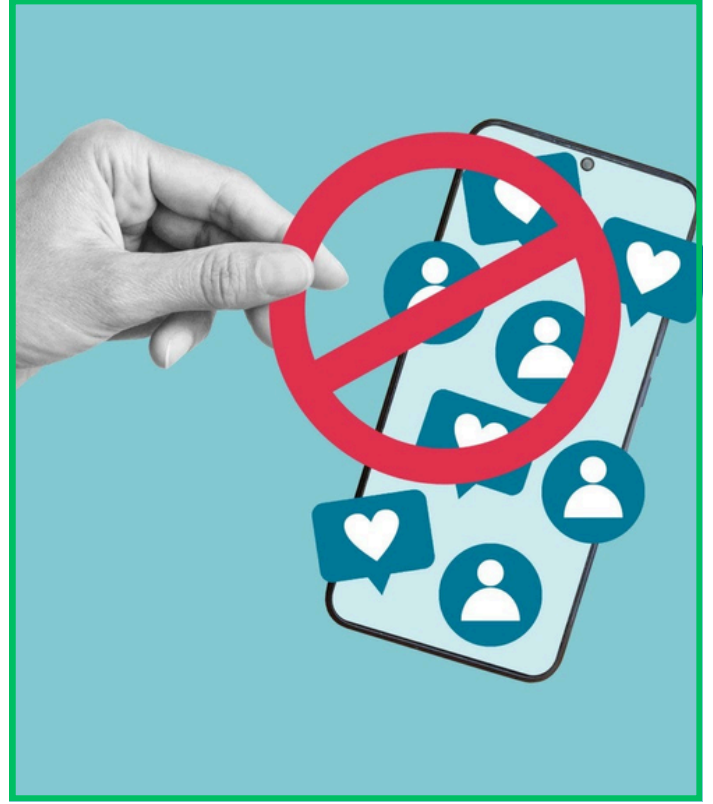


New Restrictions on Children's Social Media Use in Türkiye

A new regulation is being discussed in Turkey to restrict children's social media usage. Under the proposed law, children under the age of 13 will be prohibited from using social media, while those aged 13-16 will need parental consent to access platforms. This measure aims to enhance children's safety in the digital world. Although many platforms already prohibit users under 13 from creating accounts, research shows that children often bypass age restrictions and remain active on social media.
